Many Community and Economic Benefits of Recreation


- **\$ National**: outdoor recreation generates \$887 billion in consumer spending*
- **\$ State:** In Vermont, 55,000 direct jobs and \$5.5 billion in consumer spending
- **\$ Local:** Recreation is one of four key sectors of MRV economy.
 - \$1.8 Million in user spending generated by Blueberry Lake Trails,\$1 million by Revolution Trail, and \$640,000 Waitsfield Village Path (2016 data)
